BEHAVIOR COVENANT FOR YOUTH EVENTS

This covenant is a commitment that you are making to God, First United Methodist Church, your youth leaders, and your fellow youth in order that our trip may be a good experience for all. Every trip we participate in should reflect what we understand the Christian life to be. In some ways many of these “rules” are a given but they are listed as a reminder that to live as a Christian is to be different than a lot of that which we encounter in the world around us.

Going on a trip with FUMC’s Youth Department should be viewed as a privilege, and participants are encouraged to endeavor to grow in their Christian faith on the trip. If you breach the confidence of any of the following items we reserve the right to send you home. This is not to come across as heavy-handed but to model out the fact that the Christian life is one in which we have standards which we follow as we grow in our love for God and each other.

I acknowledge and accept that community life at a First United Methodist Church sponsored event is based upon mutual trust, respect for others, and adherence to the Christian life and to the specifics of a set of standards which are:

- that the use or possession of alcohol, illegal drugs is prohibited;
- that the use or possession of tobacco in any form is prohibited;
- that riding in or driving a motor vehicle without specific permission from the Youth Minister or youth leaders is prohibited;
- participants are expected to remain on the property which we are visiting during the time we are scheduled to be there;
- that inappropriate sexual behavior, be it implied, consensual, or verbal is not tolerated;
- that inappropriate language and behavior will not be used.
