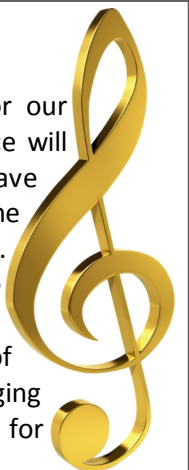


### REAL ESTATE MINISTRY TIP OF THE MONTH

## PENTECOST IS COMING!

**We will be celebrating Pentecost on Sunday, June 12.** Pentecost literally means "fifty days" or "the fiftieth day." In the Jewish faith, it came exactly fifty days after the Passover and was the festival that celebrated the completion of the harvest. In the Christian community, it is the seventh Sunday after Easter and commemorates the coming of the Holy Spirit. Some call it the birthday of the Christian Church as described in the second chapter of Acts. Many church members celebrate Pentecost by wearing "red" to church on that Sunday. The "red" brings to mind the tongues of fire described in Acts 2.



## TRINITY SUNDAY

Sunday, June 19 is Father's Day. Most of us are familiar with the celebrations that accompany this day for honoring our fathers. However, few of us know that it is also Trinity Sunday. Trinity Sunday differs from other days in the Christian calendar in that it is not associated with a particular saint or historic event. Instead, it is a day that celebrates the central doctrine of Christian theology: that the One God exists as three persons with one substance—as the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The idea of a festival in honor of the Trinity was first introduced by Stephen, Bishop of Liège, Belgium, in the 10th century. But it took several more centuries for a feast in honor of so abstract a concept to find its way into the church calendar. It became popular in England perhaps because of the consecration of Thomas à Becket on that day in 1162, but it wasn't until 1334 that it became a universal observance decreed by Pope John XXII.
