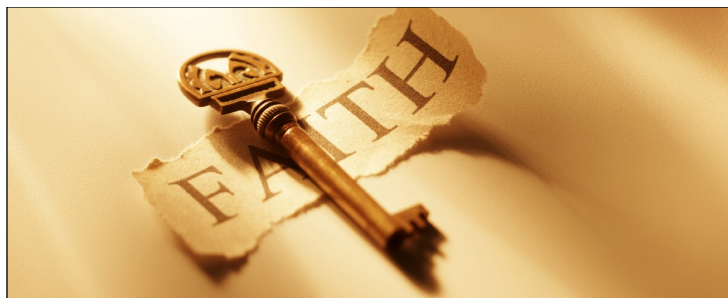


SWEETHEART DINNER FOR OUR SENIOR ADULTS
