Camp Details

COST: The cost for Camp T4G is \$65 per child (includes bus transportation to and from John Wesley Ranch, meals, T-shirt, and any other fees associated with special activities). Please make checks **payable to FUMC and write Camp T4G in the memo line.**

REGISTRATIONS: Camp T4G registration forms are available in Kingdom City and online at www.fumc-cs.org. Completed forms may be turned in to the Kingdom City Welcome Desk or be mailed to the church, Attn: Camp T4G. **REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS JUNE 30.** Packing list is also available on-line. SPECIAL REQUESTS: If your child requires medication to be administered while at Camp T4G, you must complete a separate Medication Administration Form. This form is available on-line and upon request. Also, on the back of the registration form, please make us aware of any special needs assistance your child may require.

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP: The Bus will leave FUMC Parking lot on Thursday, July 11 at 8:00 am and will return to FUMC Parking lot on Saturday, July 13 at 12:30 pm. You may drop your child off or pick up your child directly at John Wesley Ranch, but this must be coordinated on a case by case basis with Janita McGregor prior to start of the camping event.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION: John Wesley Ranch, owned and operated by First United Methodist Church for over 50 years, and affectionately referred to as "The Ranch" is located on 120 acres near Mueller State Park, outside Divide, Colorado. The address is: 21285 State Highway 67, Divide, CO, 80814. Cell phone service is undependable at John Wesley Ranch; plus we expect that the focus be on people and program. Therefore, we ask that if children bring a cell phone, they pack it away and not use it from the start of programming on Thursday until the close of programming on Saturday.
